First aid allowance	\$0.40 per hour up to a maximum of \$15.08 per week
Leading hand allowance - in charge of 3-10 employees	\$0.88 per hour
Leading hand allowance - in charge of 11-20 employees	\$1.31 per hour
Leading hand allowance - in charge of more than 20 employees	\$1.67 per hour
Meal allowance	\$13.39 per meal
Special contingency allowance - Emerald and St George - full time employee	\$69.78 per week
Special contingency allowance - Emerald and St George - seasonal worker	\$20.93 per week
Special contingency allowance - Moura and Cecil Plains - full time employee	\$48.06 per week
Special contingency allowance - Moura and Cecil Plains - seasonal worker	\$14.42 per week
