From 1 June 2020, when our staff accept any gift or other benefit (including hospitality) worth more than \$100, we'll add it to our Gift and benefits register. We'll update the register every 3 months, or within 28 days of the gift or benefit being received.

From 18 October 2019, when The Fair Work Ombudsman, Ms Sandra Parker PSM accepts any gift or other benefit (including hospitality) worth more than \$100, we'll add it to our Gift and benefits register as per Australian Public Service Commission guidelines.
